Previous to this date and for many years prior to 1905 this range was used by the applicant in connection with ranch lands lying to the west of the area.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Well 500 feet deep with 6" casing to 365' 8" level; installation of 8-9 h.p. Z gasoline engine and deep well self-oiling pump head and cement tank at site of well; installation of sheep-watering troughs about 150 feet northerly and westerly of well in same subdivision. Pipe from well to tank and from tank to troughs is 2" pipe.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1947

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 11, 1947

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 11, 1948

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 11, 1948

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 11, 1949

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 11, 1949
