2" Plunger pump operated by 3 1/2 H.P. Gasoline Engine from 60 ft. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water Cased Well delivered to a galvanized round tank 16 ft. in diameter is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions: 32" inches high through a 1 1/2 inch galvanized pipe approximately 10 ft. long.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0047 cubic foot per second, or sufficient to water 150 head of cattle.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 23, 1947

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 23, 1947

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 23, 1947

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 23, 1947

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 23, 1948

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 23, 1948
