DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water to be converted into 3 cement tanks by 2" pipe. First tank in NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 2 T. 6 S., R. 64 E. from which water is divided into two pipe lines one going S. 75° W into NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 6 S., R. 63 E. one going S. 18° W into SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 15, T. 6 S., R. 64 E.

- 5. Estimated cost of works \$10,000 Ten Thousand dollars
6. Estimated time required to construct works 5 yr. time, 2 yrs to start commence of work and 3 yrs to complete
7. Remarks At the time of my first filing for Mona Spr. it only produced enough water to support 350 head of cattle and horses but later developments showed an increase of water to support 1000 head of cattle and 100 head of horses. Therefore I am making a filing for this increase of water from Mona Spr. to the proposed points of use as submitted by maps forwarded to your office by insured mail Oct. 1st, 1945. John H. APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and further subject to the provisions set forth in the ruling of the State Engineer on this application, dated October 13, 1950. The places of use under this permit are limited to the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 12, T. 6 S., R. 63 E., unsurveyed, and the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 15, T. 6 S., R. 64 E., unsurveyed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.034 or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle and 100 horses which numbers include the stock of applicant and associates now ranging in Delamar Valley.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 20, 1951

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 20, 1951

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 20, 1952

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 20, 1952

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

May 20, 1953. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 20, 1953
