State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)



This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. A valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste of water and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be taken from time to time. This source is located within an area that has been designated by the State Engineer as coming within the meaning of the provisions of the 1939 Underground Water Act as amended in 1943; therefore the State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.045 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Nov. 1, 1946

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before Dec. 1, 1946

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Nov. 1, 1947

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before Dec. 1, 1947

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before Nov. 1, 1948

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before Dec. 1, 1948
