The undersigned El Rancho Hotel and Village Inc.
of Las Vegas, County of Clark
State of Nevada, hereby make application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as
hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place
of incorporation.) Nevada, March 28, 1946

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an underground source
in the Las Vegas Artesian Basin.
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.50 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:
At a point in the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 9, T 21 S, R 61 E, M.D.B.&M.,
and at a point from which the Northeast corner of said Section 9,
bears N 66°-16' E a distance of 1660 feet.

(i) Remarks large Hotel and Village. Two wells, Ap.Nos.10553 and 1071
are in use but the supply is not sufficient. Furthermore, at present,
there is no stand by well. If either of the two above wells should go
out of production the Applicant would be in a desperate situation. Two
applications are being put in at this time. It is proposed to connect
these new wells with the present pipe line system so that the waters
of all four wells will be co-mingled to serve all parts of the pro-
perty.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water will be diverted by a drilled well and distributed by a system of pipe lines.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. A valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste of water. A meter must be installed in the pipe line, near the point of diversion, so that accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use may be obtained. This source is located within an area that has been designated by the State Engineer as coming within the meaning of the provisions of the 1939 Underground Water Act, as amended in 1943; the State has the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.5

cubic feet per second, with the understanding that the total use under Permits 10553, 10718, 11620 and 11621 is not to exceed 648,000 gallons per day.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 12, 1947

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 12, 1947

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 12, 1948

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 12, 1948

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 12, 1949

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 12, 1949
