(i) Remarks There is a proposed subdivision within the area designa-  
ted as the place of use. The parcels are to be 2.5 acres each in-  
cluding streets, and will be served from this proposed artesian well.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water to be diverted from a drilled artesian well having an 8" casing and distributed by a system of 6" pipe lines to serve as mains and 1" pipe as laterals to each parcel of land. A 5 H.P. pump will be installed to assure constant flow. An 8" gate valve will control the flow at the source, and 6" valves along the mains.

- 5. Estimated cost of works \$10,000

7. Remarks A water appropriation must be assured, before further improvements as well as developments are undertaken on this property.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. A valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste of water. A meter must be installed in the pipe line, near the point of diversion, so that accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use may be obtained. This source is located within an area that has been designated by the State Engineer as coming within the meaning of the provisions of the 1939 Underground Water Act, as amended in 1943; the State has the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.4 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 19, 1947

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 19, 1947

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 19, 1948

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 19, 1948

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 19, 1949

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 19, 1949
