The undersigned James E. Stead Name of applicant

State of Nevada, hereby make application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as
hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place
of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Twin Springs Creek Reservoir.
2. The amount of water applied for is 500 acre-ft. per annum second-foot.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic uses.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:
The reservoir is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 3, T21N. R22E., M.D.B. & M.
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.
From the southerly end of the dam the NW Cor. Sec. 4 bears N. 64 54' W. 7932 ft.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

An earth dam about 26 ft. high, 415 ft. long. Capacity 14.5 acre-ft. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water at spill-way level. It is expected that the reservoir will be filled several times during the season.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to appropriate and store unappropriated water is granted subject to all prior rights on the source. It is understood that this reservoir may be used as a regulatory reservoir to conserve, as much as possible, the use of water claimed under vested rights.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 500 acre-feet per annum.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 15, 1947

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 15, 1947

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 15, 1949

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 15, 1949

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 15, 1951. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 15, 1951
