permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an underground source
in Las Vegas Artesian Basin, Clark County.

Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:
Within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 32, T20S, R61E, MD. B.&M. or at a point from
which the W 1/2 cor. of said Sec. 32 bears N 51° 02' W a dist. 1813 feet.

and 3 others are started, and a water appropriation is necessary
for this area which will be served exclusively.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water to be diverted from a drilled and cased artesian well, and distributed by a system of pipe line designated as the place of use.

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. A valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste of water. A meter must be installed in the pipe line, near the point of diversion, so that accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use may be obtained. This source is located within an area that has been designated by the State Engineer as coming within the meaning of the provisions of the 1939 Underground Water Act, as amended in 1973. The State has the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 16, 1947

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before January 16, 1948

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 16, 1948

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 16, 1949

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 16, 1949

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before January 16, 1950
