

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water to be diverted by means of pumping plant, and conveyed by pipe lines to all parts of the area described as the place of use. Suitable storage by means of stand pipes or tanks is contemplated at strategic points to provide required pressure for municipal and domestic purposes with supplementary booster stations as found necessary. Said municipal use to include irrigation, fire protection, domestic use and any and all uses customarily required of a public utility water system.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that in addition to the summer use as herein-after designated, the permittee will be entitled to intermittent use during the non-summer season on the basis of not to exceed fifty gallons of water per capita per day. It is understood that the amount of water granted herein is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually used. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.25

cubic feet per second., and not to exceed 161,500 gallons per day between June 1st and September 15th of each year.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 26, 1952

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 26, 1952

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 26, 1954

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 26, 1954

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 26, 1957. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 26, 1957

Proof of commencement of work filed MAY 21 1952

Proof of Completion of work filed JUL 8 1954
