

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned Van Horn & Stringfellow
of Bakersfield, County of
State of California, hereby make application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as
hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place
of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground source.
2. The amount of water applied for is three second-feet.
3. The water to be used for irrigation.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:
In the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 19 S., R. 53 E., MDM., whence the N 1/4 Cor. of
said Sec. 9, bears N. 10° 05' W., 1555 feet.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is portions of 280 acres.
(b) Description of land to be irrigated the S 1/2 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, N 1/4 SE 1/4,
E 1/2 SW 1/4, all in Sec. 9, T. 19 S., R. 53 E., MDM.

- (c) Use will begin about March 1st and end about Nov. 30th, of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, STOCK WATERING, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (d) Power to be developed is horsepower.
(e) Place of use

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

A well is to be drilled, and if artesian water is not found, to be equipped with gas driven pump.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. No right is given under this permit to maintain the water level in permittees well at any level higher than that necessary for a reasonable pumping lift. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Section 4 of the Underground Water Act; therefore the State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed 5 ac.ft. per acre of water of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 16, 1949

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 16, 1949

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 16, 1951

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 16, 1951

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 16, 1952. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 16, 1952
