hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is a spring
Name of stream, lake, or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.10 second-foot
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches

3. The water to be used for Mining and Domestic purposes
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: It is within the N 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 30, Tp. 20 N., Range 20 E., MDB&M, which is a Placer Claim known as the Hidden Valley No. 2

The water may be used on the W 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 30, and adjoining Placer Claim known as Hidden Valley No. 1

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(a) Number of acres to be irrigated is
(b) Description of land to be irrigated
Describe by legal subdivision, or if on unsurveyed land it should

be so stated and a description provided in accordance with special instruction from the State Engineer when application is returned for correction.

(c) Use will begin about Month and end about Month, of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, STOCK WATERING, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(d) Power to be developed is horsepower.

(e) Place of use The N 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 30, Tp. 20 N., Range 20 E., M.D.B.&M., and the W 1/2 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 30.

(f) Point of return of water to stream a portion of the water will return to our proposed dam. Rest of water will sink,
Describe in same manner as point of diversion

(g) State number and kinds of animals to be watered

(h) Use will begin about Month and end about Month, of each year.

(i) Remarks My purpose is to use the water to develop the two Placer Mining Claims above mentioned. I have developed the spring on one of the claims and will need all water possible to obtain. There is no possibility of interfering with anyone else.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

I propose to dam the water a short distance from the spring outlet. Part of the water will be used on the Hidden Valley #1 Placer Claim by pipeline from the dam and part of the water from the dam will be pumped and carried by pipe to the Hidden Valley #2 Placer Claim that is somewhat elevated.

All this improvement will be on the ground known as Hidden Valley Placer Claim #2, the legal subdivision of which is N 1/2 of NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 30, Tp. 20 N., Range 20 E., MDB&M.

5. Estimated cost of works \$1,000.00
6. Estimated time required to construct works prior to August 1, 1947.

7. Remarks This water was developed as a result of a trench dug at the bottom of an old water channel, and for the purpose of developing my claims and testing the various stratas of gravel. When reaching the end of the channel at the bottom of the mountain this spring of water showed up. It has developed into a flowing spring now estimated at about a Miner's inch of water. I hope to increase it with further development.
