The undersigned The St. Lawrence Mining Company, a Nevada corporation incorporated Dec. 29, 1905 Name of applicant, of Mt. Washington Mining District, County of White Pine, State of Nevada, hereby make s application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an unnamed spring, probably identical with one formerly called Grouse Spring, and to be so called Name of stream, lake, or other source
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.25 second-feet. One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches
3. The water to be used for milling and domestic use Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: In what would be the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 14 T. 12 N, R 68 E, unsurveyed, bearing N. 27° 35' W. 7,650 feet To U. S. Mineral Monument No. 1 Mount Washington Mining District, White Pine County, Nevada Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

One inch iron pipe line about three-quarters of a mile from diversion point at State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water spring to place of use is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

7. Remarks Mining property consisting of seven patented lode mining claims in Mt. Washington Mining District is now under lease and option to Shirley G. Robison, James Hulse and Victor Cotinno who desire to use this unappropriated water in their operations. Estimate of amount of water is based on report that ten inches was used in 1907 from Grouse Spring. The St. Lawrence Mining Co., Applicant.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 9, 1949

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 9, 1949

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 9, 1950

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 9, 1950

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 9, 1951

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 9, 1951
