APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement of water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. No guarantee is given to maintain the water level higher than is necessary for a reasonable pumping lift. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.40 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 7, 1949

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before April 7, 1949

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 7, 1950

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 7, 1950

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 7, 1951. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before April 7, 1951
