

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the granting of this permit does not constitute a recognition of right, title or equity in grazing privileges on the Federal Range in the Honey Lake Grazing District. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.008 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle together with domestic use.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 18, 1949

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 18, 1949

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 18, 1950

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 18, 1950

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 18, 1951

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 18, 1951
