DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water to be diverted through pipe to collection box thence through another pipe to a set of troughs, which will be in the same legal sub-division as the spring.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the number of stock watered daily, which number must be stated in the proof of beneficial use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0016 c.f.s.
