The drilling of a 8 inch diameter well to an undetermined depth, as water was encountered at a depth of 185 feet, the drilling is being continued to test deeper. A pressure tank and pumps to be installed with suitable pipe lines to serve a Health Sanitarium, residences and other business that may be desired. Well to be cased with 8" casing and piped to place of use.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. No right is given under this permit to maintain the water level in permittees well at any level higher than that necessary for a reasonable pumping lift. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Section 4 of the Underground Water Act; therefore the State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 26, 1949
Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 26, 1949
Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 26, 1951

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 26, 1951
Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 26, 1952
Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 26, 1952
