The undersigned Joe Filippini
of Battle Mountain, County of Lander, State of Nevada, hereby make application for

permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an underground source (Gravel Pit)

2. The amount of water applied for is 6.087 second-feet.

3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: In SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Section 25, T. 33 N., R. 48 E., MDM., or at a point whence the southeast corner of Section 25, Bears S. 9° 35' E., 1088.77 feet.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 608.7

(b) Description of land to be irrigated SW 1/4, Sec 13, W 1/2 of NE 1/4, NW 1/4 and portions of NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 and SW 1/4 of Section 24, NW 1/4 NW 1/4, E 1/2 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, and N 1/2 of SE 1/4 of Section 25 all in T 33 N., R. 48 E., MDM.

(c) Use will begin about Mar 15 and end about Sept 15, of each year.



DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

A pumping plant will be installed on the banks of a gravel pit located about 200 feet north of Station 68+00, Route 1: Section A3:

Eureka County, Nevada State Highway near Dunphy, Nevada. Water will be pumped into the Rose ditch and conveyed land proposed to be irrigated.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and is subject to regulation and control by the State Engineer at any time such control is necessary. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement of water.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 6.087 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 7, 1949

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before December 7, 1949

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 7, 1951

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 7, 1951

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 7, 1953. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before December 7, 1953
