State of Oregon (c/o Kearney & Adams, P.O. Box 295, Reno, Nev.) hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Blue Lakes, present source of Alder Creek
Name of stream, lake, or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 20 c.f.s. second-feet.
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic purposes
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 Sec. 1, T. 43 N., R. 28 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, at a point S. 18° 24' 44" E., 20,368.48 feet from the corner of Secs. 14, 15 22 and 23 of T. 44 N., R. 28 E., M.D.B.&M.
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

(i) Remarks By this application applicant proposes to store water in Blue Lakes situated in Sec. 1 of T. 43 N., R. 28 E., M.D.B. & M. It is intended to store the waters which now constitute the source of Alder Creek already appropriated by applicant and withdraw the same in uniform flow so far as possible, depending upon the necessity for beneficial use from time to time on applicant's lands. All the water of Alder Creek at the present time is held under vested right by applicant and there are no other users on the source.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

It is proposed to excavate the channel at the outlet of the lakes at the head of Alder Creek and install either a wooden or concrete flume or headgate with either gates or flashboards as may be deemed most expedient so as to withdraw the water when needed and to fill and refill the lakes from time to time instead of allowing the water to pass down Alder Creek in unregulated flow as at present. The fluctuation of the lakes' surface will be not more than 6 to 8 feet, but it is desired to have sufficient storage capacity to store the water developed in the watershed around the lakes.

- 5. Estimated cost of works \$5,000.00 to \$10,000.00
6. Estimated time required to construct works five years
7. Remarks The contemplated development will serve to more effectively

utilize the waters of Alder Creek which are now held by applicant under vested rights on long standing.
