permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Lake Tahoe

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: In Lake Tahoe and adjacent to the applicants Lot No. 9 of the Cave Rock Cove Limited Subdivision, which is located in Lot 2 of Section 27, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.; said point of diversion further described as bearing N. 5°28'20"E. 3248.97 feet from the meander corner common to Sections 27 and 34 of said Township and Range.



DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water will be diverted by means of pumping with a one-half horse power electric motor into a pipe system.

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is granted subject to all existing rights. It is understood that in addition to the summer use as hereinafter designated, the permittee will be entitled to intermittant use during the non-summer season on the basis of not to exceed 50 gallons per capita per day. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.002

and not to exceed 1300 gallons per day between cubic foot per second, June 1st and September 15th of each year and intermittant use during other parts of the year.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 20, 1950

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 20, 1950

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 20, 1951

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 20, 1951

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

July 20, 1953. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 20, 1953.
