hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake, or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 3.00 second-feet. One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches

3. The water to be used for Irrigation Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: In the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 10, T. 28 N., R. 49 E., MDM., or at a point whence the northeast corner of section 10, T. 28 N., R. 49 E., bears N. 86° 10' E., 1373.40 feet.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 160

(b) Description of land to be irrigated N 1/2 of SW 1/4 of section 34, and N 1/2 of SE 1/4 of section 33 all in T. 29 N., R. 49 E., MDM.

(c) Use will begin about Jan. 1st and end about Dec. 31st, of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the water right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittees well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.0

cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a duty of 3.6 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated for each season.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 2, 1950

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 2, 1950

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 2, 1952

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 2, 1952

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 2, 1954

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 2, 1954
