APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source: A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement of water. It is understood that this permit applies only to flood and surplus waters. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 13.2 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed 3 acre-feet for each acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 19, 1950

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 19, 1950

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 19, 1952

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 19, 1952

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

June 19, 1954. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 19, 1954
