APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.045 c.f.s. of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependant upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.045 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 21, 1951

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 21, 1951

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 21, 1953

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 21, 1953

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 21, 1954. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 21, 1954
