DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Dam about 10 ft. long, 2 ft. high, a carrying ditch 2 ft. wide, 1 ft. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water about 1 1/2 miles long to a reservoir 20 ft. in diam. 2 ft. deep, is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. thence by 2" pipe to 50 ft. of troughs.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.025 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 4000 head of sheep. Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 10, 1950. Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 10, 1950. Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 10, 1951. Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 10, 1951. Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 10, 1952. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 10, 1952.
