APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and further subject to that certain ruling dated March 14, 1951 in the Matter of Application No. 13123. It is understood that this water right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittees well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. Under this permit water is appertenant to the  $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , S $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 15, T. 2 S., R. 35 E., M.D.M. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 4.0 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 5 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 3, 1952

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before March 3, 1952

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 3, 1954

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 3, 1954

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 3, 1956

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before March 3, 1956
