APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned Charles Kielhofer of Tonopah, County of Nye, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Hot Springs (Pearl Springs)

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.50 second-feet.

3. The water to be used for bathing and medicinal purposes

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 30, T. 1 S., R. 40 1/2 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SW Corner of said Section 30 bears S 23 - 20' W. 1,600.00 feet.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(e) Place of use NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 30, T. 1 S., R. 40 1/2 E., unsurveyed.
(f) Point of return of water to stream

(h) Use will begin about Jan. 1 and end about Dec. 31 of each year.

(i) Remarks This application is identical with Application No. 10649 which was cancelled on Nov. 18, 1949 and the map filed in support of this cancelled application can be used to support this application.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependant upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 27, 1951

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before April 27, 1951

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 27, 1952

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 27, 1952

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

March 27, 1953

Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before April 27, 1953
