(i) Remarks This year around water will be stored in a reservoir when not used for irrigation. Stock will water at the reservoir approximately 9 months of the year. Reservoir will also serve as a settling pond. This is the excess water running from the Placer Mining dredge operated by the Natomas Mining Company, after its necessary use by them.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Small earth dam will be constructed at the point of diversion. Water State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water to be conveyed from the point of diversion to a reservoir or settling pond located approximately in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 22, T. 30 N., R. 43 E. by means of a ditch., and thence from the reservoir by ditch to the Reese River where it will be rediverted into the ditch covered by Permit No. 3864.
