of North Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an underground source in Las Vegas Artesian Basin, Clark County, Nev.
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.20 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic purposes
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: Within NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 19, T.20 S., R.62 E., MDM or at a point from which the NW of said Sec.19 bears North 67°27' West a distance of 1936 feet.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 5 acres
(b) Description of land to be irrigated N 1/2 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 19, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., MDM

- (c) Use will begin about Jan. 1st and end about Dec. 31st, of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, STOCK WATERING, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (d) Power to be developed is none horsepower.
(e) Place of use
(f) Point of return of water to stream

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water to be diverted from a drilled cased artesian well, and distributed by a system of pipe lines to various places of use for domestic purposes, and ditches for irrigation purposes. A gate valve will be installed for control purposes, and pumping facilities will be installed if it is necessary to do so.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. No right is given under this permit to maintain the water level in permittees well at any level higher than that necessary for a reasonable pumping lift. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Section 4 of the Under-ground water act; therefore the State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.15 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a duty of 6.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 3, 1950

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 3, 1950

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 3, 1951

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 3, 1951

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 3, 1952. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 3, 1952
