

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned LAS VEGAS THOROUGHBRED RACING ASSOCIATION
of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.) Nevada, November, 1946

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground water from Las Vegas Artesian Basin
2. The amount of water applied for is one-half second-feet.
3. The water to be used for race track operation
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: from a point in SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 10, T. 21 S., Range 61 E., from which the Southwest corner of said section bears S. 22° 17' 58" W., 3445'.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application,

and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. A valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste of water. A meter must be installed in the pipe line near the point of diversion, so that accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use may be obtained. This source is located within an area that has been designated by the State Engineer as coming within the meaning of the provisions of the 1939 Underground Water Act as amended in 1943; the State has the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is further understood that the yearly amount of water used from wells under Permits 13278, 13368, 13369 and 13370 shall be limited to 550 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 25, 1951

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before February 25, 1951

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 25, 1952

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 25, 1952

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

January 25, 1954. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before February 25, 1954
