This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 1.0 cubic foot of water per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 25, 1952.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 25, 1952.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 25, 1953.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 25, 1953.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 25, 1954.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before May 25, 1954.
