State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Little Humboldt River and tributaries.
Name of stream, lake, or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 157.54 second-feet.
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches

3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:
SW 1/4 of NW 1/4, Sec. 8, Tp. 40 N., R. 40 E.
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(b) Description of land to be irrigated All or parts of lands in Sections 3, 4, 8, 9 and 10, Tp. 38 N., R. 39 E; and 1, 2, 4, 9, 10, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 33, 34 and 36, Tp. 39 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M. (See Exhibit "A")
Describe by legal subdivision, or if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated and a description provided in accordance with special instruction from the State Engineer when application is returned for correction.

(c) Use will begin about Jan. 4 and end about Dec. 31st, of each year.

The crops produced on lands referred to, with exception of small acreage, are native hay and grasses dependent upon early irrigation which is then sufficient to mature crop. Such was and is natural cycle of growth. Late waters now decreed to lands are oftentimes too late to be of much benefit to native hay and grass crops. Source of water supply, in this instance Little Humboldt, while in flood stage before official irrigation season is fixed carries sufficient water (undecreed) to service this application. Thereafter, and after official fixing of irrigation season (period of decreed use) there is generally insufficient water to properly flood irrigate lands and consequently crop productivity is lost or greatly lessened. The Little Humboldt carried considerable "free" water prior to fixed irrigation season which is now available for applicant's needs.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

(Same) Reinforced concrete diversion dam will be built at diversion

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water point with proper regulating devices. As indicated in (7) below is to be stored in reservoir, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. the-present system of canals, ditches and laterals will be used to convey water to lands to be irrigated.

- 7. Remarks There is not an established system of irrigation which has been used for many years in connection with lands for which the water applied for will be used. The present system will be enlarged and modified to accomodate use of water applied for.
