The undersigned Kennecott Copper Corporation
of McGill, County of White Pine, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.) New York State

2. The amount of water applied for is Fifteen second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Milling and Domestic Purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Sec. 12, T. 18 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B.&M. whence the West Corner of said Sec. 12 bears N 80° 33' 10" W., 4940 ft. distant.

Water to be pumped by three Ingersol-Rand Electric pumps, each having a capacity of 5 C.F.S. thru a 20", 24" & 26" pipe line to a relay pumping plant where three Dayton-Dowd Electric Pumps 350 H.P. each pump the water thru a 30 inch pipe line to the mill.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 15.0 cubic foot of water per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 15.0 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1952

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 28, 1952

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 28, 1953

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 28, 1953

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 28, 1953

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 28, 1953
