permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as
hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an underground source
in Las Vegas Artesian Basin, Paradise Valley, Clark County, Nev.
2. The amount of water applied for is 1.00 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for irrigation & domestic purposes
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:
Within SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Sec. 6, T. 22 S., R. 62 E., MD.M.Nev. or at a point from
which the NE corner of said Sec. 6 bears North 56°42' East a dist. of
2859 feet.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 600 Acres
(b) Description of land to be irrigated NE 1/4 NE 1/4; S 1/4 NE 1/4; NE 1/4 SW 1/4; S 1/4 SW 1/4;
N 1/4 SE 1/4; and SW 1/4 SE 1/4 all within Sec. 6, T. 22 S., R. 62 E. Also NW 1/4 and
W 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 7, T. 22 S., R. 62 E. MD.M.Nev.

- (c) Use will begin about Jan. 1st and end about Dec. 31st, of each year.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water to be diverted from a 10" cased artesian well and distributed by State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water a system of pipe lines to various places of use for domestic purposes, is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions, and ditches for irrigation purposes. Valves will be installed for control purposes. Pumping facilities will be installed should it be found necessary in order to develop water.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittees well due to other ground water development in the area. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Section 4 of the 1939 Ground Water Act (Chap. 178, Stats. 1939 as amended 1949); therefore the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 2, 1952

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 2, 1952

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 2, 1953

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 2, 1953

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 2, 1954

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 2, 1954
