2. The amount of water applied for is 6.00 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 19, T. 16 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B.&M.
