of Wellington, County of Lyon, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.) June 23, 1948, Carson City, Nevada

- (c) Use will begin about Apr. 1 and end about Oct. 31, of each year.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to appropriate waste water is herewith granted subject to existing rights and further subject to the stipulation between Applicant and L. E. and Myrle Tripp dated February 4, 1952.

Since this permit is to appropriate waste water, it is understood that the permit herein granted is issued subject to the availability of water and carries with it no provision or guarantee for the continuous use of such waste water.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 7.5 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 3, 1956

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 3, 1956

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 3, 1958

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 3, 1958

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 3, 1959

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 3, 1959
