of Goodsprings, County of Clark, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the number of stock watered daily, which number must be stated in the proof of beneficial use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed .0081 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 250 head of cattle & 10 horses.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 17, 1952

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before January 17, 1953

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 17, 1953

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 17, 1954

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

December 17, 1953. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before January 17, 1954
