permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.) December 18, 1925, Colorado. (Authorized to transact Business in Nevada)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Goldacres Well No. 2 (Underground source) Name of stream, lake, or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 1.5 second-feet. One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches

3. The water to be used for Mining, Milling and Domestic purposes. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NE1/4 of Section 33, T. 28 N, R 47 E of MDM; or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 33, T 28 N, R 47 E, MDM bears N 33°08' E, 1480 feet.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 1.5 cubic feet of water per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.5 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 23, 1953

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 23, 1953

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 23, 1954

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 23, 1954

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

July 23, 1955. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 23, 1955
