This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued with the understanding that the livestock of all other qualified grazing permittees shall have privileges to water at the source at any and all times, and also issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the number of stock watered daily, which number must be stated in the proof of beneficial use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0046 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 150 head of cattle.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 25, 1956

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before February 25, 1956

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 25, 1957

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 25, 1957

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before January 25, 1957

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before February 25, 1957
