The undersigned Fowler Mining Corp. of Dyer, County of Esmeralda, State of Nevada, hereby make s application for

permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.) Sept. 11, 1952 -- Reno, Nevada

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and is further subject to the provisions set forth in the ruling dated July 8, 1953 issued under Application No. 14465. It is understood that the 0.25 c.f.s. of water per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount

which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 21, 1954

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before February 21, 1954

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 21, 1955

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 21, 1955

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

January 21, 1956. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before February 21, 1956
