The undersigned Harvey J. Dixon of Las Vegas, County of Nevada, State of Nevada, hereby make S application for

permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.) Individual

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an underground source in Las Vegas Artesian Basin, Clark County, Nev.
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.40 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic purposes
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: Within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 29, T 20 S, R 62 E, MD.M. Nev. or at a point from which the NW. corner of said Sec. 29 bears North 45°00' West a distance of 212 feet.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 40 acres
(b) Description of land to be irrigated NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 29, T 20 S, R 62 E, MD.M. Nev.

- (c) Use will begin about Jan. 1st and end about Dec. 31st, of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, STOCK WATERING, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION

- (d) Power to be developed is horsepower.
(e) Place of use
(f) Point of return of water to stream

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water to be diverted from 10" drilled and cased artesian Well and dis-

tributed by a system of pipe lines to various places of use for Domestic purposes and ditches for Irrigation purposes within the area designated as the place of use. Pumping facilities will be installed to develop water should it be necessary to do so, together with valves, gates and fittings for control purposes.

- 5. Estimated cost of works \$3000 (Approximately)
- 6. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years
- 7. Remarks It is proposed to improve the land designated as the place of use with a dwelling and cultivate the entire area for alfalfa.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 0.40 c.f.s.. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittees well due to other ground water development in the area. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Section 4 of the 1939 Ground-Water Act (Chap. 178, Stats. 1939 as amended 1949); therefore the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.40

cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 6 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 14, 1953

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 14, 1953

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 14, 1954

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 14, 1954

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

July 14, 1955. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 14, 1955
