The undersigned Walter E. Wadham
of Salem, 578 Rose Street, County of Marion, State of Oregon, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground
2. The amount of water applied for is three(3.0) second-feet.
3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic use
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NE 1/4 of SE 1/4, Sec. 13, T. 20 S., R. 52 E. M.D.M. from which the SE Cor. 13, T. 20 S., R. 52 E., M.D.M. bears S 20 10' E 2553 ft.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 160
(b) Description of land to be irrigated SE 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 20 S., R. 52 E., M.D.M.

- (c) Use will begin about Jan. 1 and end about Dec. 31, of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 3.0 c.f.s. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittees well due to other ground water development in the area. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Section 4 of the 1939 Ground-Water Act (Chap. 178, Stats. 1939 as amended); therefore the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 5 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 21, 1953

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 21, 1953

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 21, 1954

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 21, 1954

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 21, 1956

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 21, 1956
