of Vista, County of San Diego, State of California, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

- (c) Use will begin about Jan. 1 and end about Dec. 31, of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and

conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 5.0 c.f.s. to irrigate 320 acres in the N 1/2 of Section 19. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste.

It is understood that the right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittees well due to other ground water development in the area. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Section 4 of the 1939 Ground-Water Act (Chap. 178, Stats. 1939 as amended); therefore the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount

which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 5.0

cubic feet per second, and not to exceed 5 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 9, 1953

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before January 9, 1954

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 9, 1954

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 9, 1955

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

December 9, 1956. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before January 9, 1957
