The undersigned Lavell Jarrett, Glen Jarrett and Clyde Graff

State of Nevada, hereby make application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as
hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place
of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground source,
Las Vegas Artesian Basin.

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.08 second-feet.

3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic purposes

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point:
SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 2, T. 22 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. It being
N. 18 degrees 33' - 00" E. a distance of 1942.0 feet from the point of
diversion (proposed) to the N. 1/4 Corner of said Section 2.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 0.08 c.f.s. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittees well due to other ground water development in the area. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Section 4 of the 1939 Ground-Water Act (Chap. 178, Stats. 1939 as amended); therefore the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.08 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 21, 1954

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 21, 1954

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 21, 1955

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 21, 1955

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

April 21, 1956

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before May 21, 1956
