S. 56 degrees - 21' - 00" E. 749.9 feet.

A 5 H. P. pump with adequate motor and a 2,000 gallon capacity tank are to be the initial installations and adequate pipe lines will be constructed to serve the area as developed.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: source and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 0.05 c.f.s. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A meter must be installed in the discharge pipe line, near the point of diversion, and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittees well due to other ground water development in the area. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Section 4 of the 1939 Ground-Water Act (Chap. 178, Stats. 1939 as amended); therefore the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 20, 1954

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 20, 1954

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 20, 1955

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 20, 1955

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 20, 1956

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 20, 1956
