DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Applicant proposes to construct a dam across Cottonwood Creek and to divert State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water flood waters and seasonal flow at point of diversion to lands in Section 16 is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. where water will be used, at any time available, to soak ground prior to planting periods or to irrigate during growing season. Water from Cottonwood Creek will be used to supplement water from wells.

- 5. Estimated cost of works \$1,000.00
6. Estimated time required to construct works three years
7. Remarks Not possible to estimate amount of water which will be available due to greatly varied flood stages and seasonal run off. Up to 900 acre feet could be used annually if available.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 900 acre-feet per annum. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittees well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept, and a method provided, either air line or opening, for measuring depth to water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 900 acre-feet per annum, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 8 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 27, 1955

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before April 27, 1955

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 27, 1957

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 27, 1957

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 27, 1959. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before April 27, 1959
