DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Spring will be developed and water consolidated and transported in a State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water pipeline (varying from 1 1/2" to 3/4" to the place of use in the bottom is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions of the canyon.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the number of stock watered daily, which number must be stated in the proof of beneficial use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0046 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 150 head of cattle.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 3, 1955

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 3, 1955

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 3, 1956

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 3, 1956

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 3, 1957

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 3, 1957
