This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. Since the source of this water is Waste Water (Robinson and Murry overflow ditch), such waters would be classed as "Waste Waters." Therefore, the permit granted herein carries with it no provision or guarantee for the continuous use of such waste. This permit is issued only for irrigation purposes as the water to be appropriated hereunder is unfit for domestic purposes.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 11.1 cubic feet per second, or 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated per season.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 9, 1964

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 9, 1964

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 9, 1965

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 9, 1965

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

June 9, 1968. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 9, 1968
