The undersigned Michael H. Pettibone
of Haines, County of Baker, State of Oregon, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

2. The amount of water applied for is 4.5 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: In the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 16, T. 44 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M., at a point which bears S. 89° 49' E. 15,764 feet from the N.W. Cor. of Sec. 13, T. 44 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M.

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 320
(b) Description of land to be irrigated NW 1/4 NW 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 16, T. 44 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M.

- (c) Use will begin about Jan. 1 and end about Dec. 31, of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 3.5 c.f.s. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittees well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept, and a method provided, either air line or opening, for measuring depth to water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.5

cubic feet per second, or a yearly duty of 4 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 14, 1957

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 14, 1957

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 14, 1958

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 14, 1958

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

August 14, 1962

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 14, 1962
