DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Upon completion of well a 25 H.P. pump and motor will be installed along with a 7,500 gallon tank all to be located immediately adjacent to the point of diversion (well location). There will be a network of pipes installed to serve the International Spa. This system has not as yet been designed.

5. Estimated cost of works \$3,500 to \$5,000 exclusive of well and distribution system.

6. Estimated time required to construct works 30 to 60 days

7. Remarks map. Well No. 2 is covered by another application. These two wells will serve the International Spa and at a later date it is planned to drill two additional wells to supply the necessary water for the housing development and other developments.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation when water is available from the Las Vegas Valley Water District, and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 0.40 c.f.s. A meter must be installed in the discharge pipe line, near the point of diversion, and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Sec. 4 of the 1939 Ground-Water Act (Chap. 178, Stats. 1939 as amended); therefore the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.40 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 26, 1955

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 26, 1955

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 26, 1956

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 26, 1956

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 26, 1957

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 26, 1957
