The undersigned International Spa, Incorporated
of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.) November 8, 1953, Reno, Nevada

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Las Vegas Artesian Basin - Well No. 2.
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.40 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for quasi-municipal and domestic
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 20 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 12 bears S. 87° 06' 20" W. 2566.2 feet.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Upon completion of well a 25 H.P. pump and motor will be installed

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water along with a 7,500 gallon tank all to be located immediately adjacent is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions, to the point of diversion (well location). There will be a network of pipes installed to serve the International Spa. This system as yet has not been designed.

5. Estimated cost of works \$3,500 to \$5,000 exclusive of well and distribution system.

6. Estimated time required to construct works 30 to 60 days

7. Remarks This application pertains to Well No. 2 on the accompanying map. Well No. 1 is covered by another application. These two wells will supply water for the International Spa and at a later date it is planned to drill two additional wells to supply the necessary water to the housing and other developments.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation when water is available from the Las Vegas Valley Water District, and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 0.40 c.f.s. A meter must be installed in the discharge pipe line, near the point of diversion, and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Sec. 4 of the 1939 Ground-Water Act (Chap. 178, Stats. 1939 as amended); therefore the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.40 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 26, 1955

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 26, 1955

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 26, 1956

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 26, 1956

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 26, 1957. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 26, 1957
