DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water to be diverted from a 8" drilled and cased Artesian Well and distributed in State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions by a system of pipe lines to various places of use on the parcel of land to be improved. Pumping facilities and appurtenances thereto will be installed to develop water.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation when water is available from the Las Vegas Valley Water District, and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed an accumulated total of 1440 gallons per day. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Section 4 of the 1939 Ground-Water Act (Chap. 178, Stats. 1939 as amended); therefore the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed an accumulated total of 1440 gallons per day.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 7, 1955

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before January 7, 1956

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 7, 1956

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 7, 1957

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 7, 1956. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before January 7, 1957
